As a manufacturer of precision parts with a focus on machining difficult-to-cut materials, the family-run company based in Rosenfeld has successfully established itself on the international market. Its modern machinery and many years of expertise in the machining of stainless steels, titanium and high-strength aluminum alloys enable it to offer a broad product portfolio for almost all industries.

For more than 45 years, the Swabian medium-sized company with 170 employees has been impressing customers with the highest product quality, flexibility, speed and fair conditions. The close cooperation with its sister company FLURO-Gelenklager GmbH requires continuous investment in modern production and automation technology in order to supply customers with highly complex precision parts in small and medium batch sizes and to be able to produce large batch sizes of FLURO standard and special parts competitively.

One of the Group's main objectives is to maintain the economically sustainable manufacture of products at the Rosenfeld site in the long term and to continue to be an attractive employer in the region. Consequently, future-oriented planning and upcoming investments are geared towards continuously expanding the site.

In particular, the company is currently investing heavily in the automation of the assembly of spherical plain bearings and rod ends as well as in the production of the components required for this. Dependencies on foreign suppliers are to be reduced in order to maintain supply chains even in difficult times. The synergies resulting from the successful cooperation between the two companies will enable intelligent solutions to be developed that traditional retailers cannot offer in the standard parts sector.
